“Besides just feeling wanted and loved, they provide the clothing and, if I need something, they provide bus passes so I can get to and from job interviews and jobs. So, in that respect, everything that I have at this point is because of them. So, it's like a 12-month program, the steps to, you know, get you out there and get you acclimated back into the workforce. And then they would ask that you would save 60% of your income so that when the time comes that you're looking for housing, that you are an affordable candidate.

“I'm thankful for Fairhaven because, when things went wrong in my past and my health failed me, they were here for me and they've provided for me, not only in the physical sense but spiritually and that's the blessing. It's two-fold, you know, that not only am I getting fed, but I'm also getting fed spiritually as well.”

## A Word from the New Life Program

My name is Bryon Harvey, and I'm the program manager for the New Life Program. I want to tell you a little bit about how it works.

The NLP is a holistic undertaking. We take a "strengths-based" approach to case management, starting where the client is in their walk with the Lord and how they see themselves in relation to God's plan for their lives. We progress on to find what gifting God the Creator has endowed them with. Instead of operating out of a spirit of lack and despair, we focus on Jesus as our redeemer, and ourselves as active participants in His will.

The NLP extends this undertaking to the overnight emergency shelter clients as well as women and families who come for dinner and chapel but do not stay overnight, in the form of non-residential case management, where God's faithfulness has been on full display since its implementation. This ranges from vision-planning and figuring out next steps regarding where and how they can worship God when they're outside Fairhaven, to providing the same spiritual guidance and informative support - as far as community resources - that we utilize in the NLP.

The work that we do through the grace of the Lord is intentional toward transformative life change. Our work is done to see the Goodness of God in the land of the living as told to us in Psalm 27, to increase our faith, and to seek out better solutions to physical and mental health concerns, housing and economic hardships.
